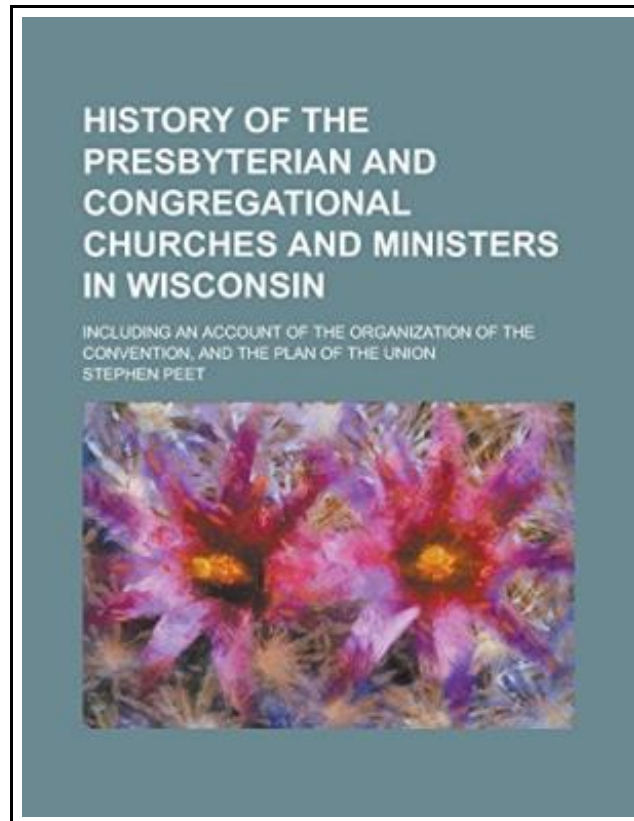

Excerpt: . . . in October 1845, where he continued to labor until the time of his melancholy death, which occurred April 26, 1847, He was a young man of undoubted piety and good talents. His prospects of a life of usefulness were cheering, and his friends fondly anticipated great good from his labors in this western field. But the ways of Providence are often mysterious. He died by his own hands, under a gloomy mental derangement, at the age of 27, having been in the ministry less than two years. Rev. Eber Child. Died at Fulton, Rock Co. , December 15, 1847, aged 48 years. He was a native of Vermont. Was educated at Dartmouth College and Andover Theological Seminary. Was settled a few years at Deering, N. H. , and at Calais, Me. In 1839 he came to western New York and labored several years, principally at Byron and Newstead. Came to Wisconsin in October 1846. Preached at Mt. Zion several months, and had removed his family into the town of Fulton, (east side of Rock River, ) where he expected to organize a church and preach alternately, there and at Mt. Zion. He died after a very short sickness, leaving evidence from a life of consistent piety and usefulness, of his being an accepted servant of Christ. Rev. A. D. Harris. Came to Wisconsin in October 1849 in feeble health, and was not able to preach after his arrival. He reached VVaupun where he remained...
